Thanks to its glazed porcelain construction, Reservoir panels are impervious, so they can be used in freeze thaw climates, wet areas like showers and steam baths, and their size scales them appropriately to be used as backsplashes in kitchens without the maintenance worry of natural stone or wood materials. All this at a fraction of the weight of their natural stone counterparts!
